### **EMIN Bus at Taizé Community Workshop 15 May 2018 – 15.00**

The EMIN Bus will make a stop at **Taizé** on 15<sup>th</sup> of May. The **Taizé Community** is an [ecumenical Christian monastic](#) community in [Taizé, Saône-et-Loire, Burgundy, France](#). The community has become one of the world's most important sites of Christian [pilgrimage](#), with a focus on youth. Over 100,000 young people from around the world make pilgrimages to Taizé each year. It is composed of more than one hundred brothers, from [Catholic](#) and [Protestant](#) traditions, who originate from about thirty countries across the world.

The idea of the EMINBUS was partly born in **Taizé** during a great gathering there in 2015 to celebrate the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of Brother Roger founder of the Taizé community. During this week Fintan Farrell, coordinator of EMIN had a chance meeting with Sr Simone Campbell of #nunsonthe bus and from there the idea grew.

While the spirit of the EMIN Bus trip is decidedly humanist , the link with faith communities is an important part of the effort to mobilise diverse actors to push for the progressive realisation of adequate, accessible and enabling Minimum Income Schemes. During the stop in **Taizé** a **workshop** will be held with the young people gathered there to look at the role and importance of Minimum Income Schemes in ensuring that everyone can have access to a good life.
